Interstate practice.

- (A) A non-resident architect may practice in the state of Ohio when said architect holds a current and valid Ohio registration.
- (B) A non-resident architect seeking an architectural commission in this state, who ~~qualifies under paragraph (A) of this rule and~~ holds a current ~~council record~~Certificate issued by the "National Council of Architectural Registration Boards" (NCARB) and is otherwise eligible for registration in the state of Ohio shall be ~~admitted to the state for the purpose of offering~~permitted to offer to render architectural services and only that without having first been issued a certificate of qualification to practice architecture by this board, provided the non-resident architect discloses the registration status to the offeree.
